BISHOP BARRON on the sexual abuse scandal: In response to the 37% of RC's who are thinking about leaving the Church because of the scandal, he writes: "As I argue, there's never really a good reason to leave the Church. There's good reason to protest, be angry, raise your voice and call for reforms. There's good reason for all of that. But to absent oneself from the source of spiritual life and from Christ, I mean, there's never a good reason for that. So, I wanted to address Catholics who maybe felt tempted in that regard." SEAL OF CONFESSION: A California bill that would have required priests to violate the seal of confession has been withdrawn by its sponsor the day before it was to be debated in committee. ... Cardinal Mauro Piacenza, head of the Vatican's Apostolic Penitentiary (which handles cases related to the seal of confession) issued a document underlining the "intrinsic requirement" of total secrecy regarding the sacrament of confession.
